INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ACCOMMODATION

Rationale:

The SGHS International Student Accommodation Policy reflects the Accommodation provisions in line with the Ministry of Education Code of Practice for International Students, Part 6.

Guidelines

- 1. To provide suitable living environment arrangements which ensure International students are able to study in a safe and supportive environment.
- 2. To provide peace of mind for all stake-holders knowing that the International Students are being cared for in high quality accommodation,
- 3. To provide support for the International Students so they are comfortable and happy in one of SGHS's accommodation options.
- 4. To ensure there are procedures in place to maintain high quality accommodation provisions by the various selected providers.
- 5. The Director of International Students will have oversight of all International Students accommodation options.1

Procedures

- The Director of International Students will decide the appropriate choice of accommodation in conjunction with the international students parents and their Agent.
- The Director of International Students (DIS) will maintain close contact with all accommodation providers and carry out regular quality assurance checks 6 monthly, with the various providers.
- The SEIBA Accommodation Procedures (Appendix 1) are to be used as the main reference point to ensure the correct procedures are being followed.
- Any accommodation issues or concerns must be directed to the Director of International Students in the first instance.
- The DIS will collect feedback from students in an annual survey which includes questions on accommodation provisions.
