Application Process

The 2022 Southland Girls' High School Colours Awards will be held on Thursday 27th October from 5.00 - 7.00pm In the West Hall.

Applications

Applications are open for Year 12 and 13 Students to apply for Colours Awards in Sports, Performing Arts and Significant Achievement Categories.

All applications are to be submitted either in writing or email to the Director of Sports, Mrs Jess Huia by Tuesday 27th September at 9.00am. Email: jess.huia@southlandgirls.school.nz

If you are applying for more than one activity, a separate application is required for each sport/discipline. Include all achievements, commendations from 2021 - 2022.

Application Criteria

- Represented the school in a Senior A Team, Individual Sport, or Performing Arts Discipline, concurrently for 2 years and currently playing/competing.
- Achieved a High Placing (relevant to numbers competing) at Otago/Southland, South Island or National level.
- At Year 13 have contributed as an official/coach to a team concurrently for 2 years and currently involved.
- Include achievements/results from 2021 - 2022.
- A separate application must be completed if you are applying for a colour in more than one discipline.
- This application makes you eligible for the Colour Award **but is not an automatic selection**
- The final decision is at the discretion of the Colours Committee
- T.I.Cs and Coaches endorsements will be included during the application process.

Dates

Applications Open **Friday 16th September**
Applications Close **Tuesday 27th September**

All students will be notified by Friday 30th September on the outcome of their application. Letters will be sent to all students who apply. Whanau are invited to attend the Colours Awards evening.

Application Forms will be emailed electronically to all Year 12 and 13 Students. Hard copies are available from the Sports Office.

Note: Applications make you eligible for the Colours Award, but it is not an automatic selection. The final decision is at the discretion of the Colours Committee.

Performing Arts	Categories: Dance, Drama, Music, Cultural <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Performed consistently at a high level in the school and wider community, regionally or nationally• Have been a leader of an activity in a creative or administrative capacity
Significant Achievement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Represented the school in an event/s or discipline other than Sport or Performing Arts• Competed in an event/s and achieved a high placing at Otago/Southland, South Island or National Level
