SCHOLARSHIP

WESTERN SOUTHLAND VETERINARY CLUB INC. (the club)

This Scholarship has been established in recognition of the increasingly technical demands of modern Agriculture and the considerable cost of tertiary study to students and their families. The primary aim is to assist a person training to become a Vet. The club also wishes to encourage and assist young persons beginning a career in agriculture to obtain the best possible education. The Scholarship shall be to the value of \$10,000 and may be awarded in total to one person or divided among two or more, at the discretion of the directors.

Applications will be invited in October of each year (depending on whether the scholarship is available). Previous recipients may reapply, upon satisfactorily completing course work in each year preceding re-application.

Eligible Courses

- 1. Study towards a degree in Veterinary Science.
- 2. Any course providing study in agriculture or farming practice at a Polytechnic, University or other Tertiary Institution, either towards a diploma, degree or other qualification.

Eligible Persons

At the discretion of the directors, any person, being a NZ citizen or a permanent resident, in Southland who has been accepted for study of an eligible course. The acceptance at an eligible course may be confirmed later but in the event the scholarship may not be made available before confirmation of acceptance. Confirmation of your course must be provided before the funds will be released.

The Scholarship is directed both at School leavers and persons who may have left School, but now wish to undertake further studies.

IF YOU WITHDRAW FROM YOUR COURSE THE DIRECTORS REQUIRE BEING ADVISED ASAP. AT THEIR DISCRETION THE SCHOLARSHIP MAY BE TERMINATED & A FULL OR PARTIAL REFUND REQUESTED.
