School zone speed limit changes, Invercargill City Council have recently advertised that variable speed limits are being introduced outside schools. Southland Girls' High School is one of the first schools.
Speeds will be reduced to 30km/h during school pick up and drop off times, this is part of Kotahi's Road to Zero strategy. Electronic signage showing this has been installed outside the school by the ICC.
