



EXTRA-CURRICULAR GUIDELINES

Pastoral

If students have a pattern or a number of incidents that demonstrate poor behaviours and a lack of respect for staff and students, their participation in extra-curricular activities will be reviewed.

Role models

Students must follow the school rules and school values of Respect, Responsibility, and Integrity consistently.

Learning

To be eligible for extra-curricular events students must demonstrate that they are engaged in their learning and that their learning is up to date; e.g. assessments and homework completed and handed in on time.

Finance

Please note that the School Policy requires payment in full by the due date for your child to be eligible to participate in this event. Payments will be allocated to any unpaid fees and charges on your child's account first.

Attendance

A record of poor attendance will result in the student's participation in extra-curricular activities being reviewed.

Medical

It is the responsibility of parents and whānau to ensure that the student's medical information is up to date. Please contact Student Services to update.
