If you meet the majority of the guidelines appropriate to your activity, your application will be considered for a "Significant Achievement" Colour Award.

- You must be in Year 12 or 13.
- Represented the school in an event/s or discipline other than Sport or Performing Arts.
- Achieved a high placing (relevant to numbers competing) at Otago/Southland, South Island or national level
- Include achievements/results from 2022 2023.

Note: This application makes you eligible for the Colour Award <u>but is not an automatic selection</u>. The final decision is at the discretion of the Colours Committee. A separate application must be completed if you are applying for a colour in more than one discipline.
