Choir will be announced week 2 with rehearsals starting 12 February.</p>

This is a full year commitment.</p> <p>Sanguine competes in the NZCF Big Sing as well as performs at Open Night and Prizegiving.</p> <p>Expressions of interest and group auditions to decide on voice part will happen week 4 (16-20 Feb) with the choir having its first rehearsal week 5: 25 February.</p> <p>Rehearsals will be on a Wednesday lunchtime.</p>
	<p>SGHS Year 7 and 8 Choir. Audition entry. ROSSO will be involved in Sing Out as well as some other exciting events for 2026</p> <p>AUDITIONS will begin 2 March</p> <p>Students will audition in pairs.</p> <p>Choir rehearsals will begin 12 March during lunchtime</p>
<p>ITINERANT MUSIC</p>	<p>Registrations are available during the first two weeks of Term One. The registration form can be found online. Lessons are available in Strings, Woodwind, Brass, Piano, Vocal, Guitar and Drums / Percussion.</p> <p>Meetings with Itinerant teachers will take place week 4 with lessons starting week 5 (23 February).</p>

<p>SHOWQUEST</p>	<p>Auditions of Year 7-13 students will take place in term one for this Performing Arts Competition run by the Captains of Dance, Music, and Drama.</p> <p>There will be a participation cost. Rehearsals will be during lunch hours.</p> <p>The event is on 22 May.</p>

<p>SHAKESPEARE GLOBE CENTRE NZ: SGCNZ</p> 	<p>Available to Year 9-13 students enthusiastic about performing Shakespeare with a modernised twist. 15 minutes or 5-minute student directed pieces can be entered in the competition each year. This event takes place in late March, early April. Rehearsals are in students' own time.</p>
<p>OLI ULA</p> 	<p>Oli Ula is a showcase performance group for students wanting to express their Pasifika culture. The group performs at school events, assemblies, in the community and at Polyfest. To be part of this group you must commit to regular practices and be available for performances. Practices are held on a Monday and Tuesday lunchtime but extend to afterschool as Polyfest approaches.</p>
<p>KAPA HAKA</p> 	<p>There are two Kapahaka groups at SGHS.</p> <p>Junior Kapahaka for Years 7-8 and Senior Kapahaka for Years 9-13 practise weekly in preparation for school and regional events. All of our girls are very passionate about kapahaka as it gives them a sense of belonging and identity.</p> <p>Events locally and regionally include:</p> <p>Te Pūtangitangi - Junior Kapahaka annual competition</p> <p>Hautoka - Senior Kapahaka competition biannual - alternates, between Murihiku then Otākou.</p>
<p>DANCE NZ MADE</p> 	<p>Year 7-13 dancers have the opportunity to take part in this annual event.</p> <p>Rehearsals will be at lunchtime and be organised and run by our school Dance Captain.</p> <p>The event is on 24 August.</p>
<p>SMOKEFREE ROCKQUEST</p> 	<p>Smokefree Rockquest is an annual music competition for intermediate and high school bands throughout New Zealand, held on 12 June. If you have always wanted to be in a band, now is your chance. Get those drumsticks or guitar out or blow the dust off those vocal chords!</p> <p>More info will be in notices and on social media. <p>BANDS</p> 	<p>If you would like to be in a school band rehearsals will be at lunchtimes. We will work towards taking part in Smokefree Rockquest. Watch the notices for information.</p>
